

Prayer Focus This Week

Someone once said “There needs to be a death before there can be a resurrection.” We here at WCOG and tens of thousands of others around the world have been fervently praying for God to move in six separate areas this past week. Lord we ask for physical, emotional, and economic resurrectional healing to begin happening in unprecedented, unexplainable ways man has never imagined. Bring healing and hope to all those touched by the virus!

MEDIA

Father we ask that You resurrect unprecedented conviction on the hardened hearts of the biased media in ways they cannot resist. Bring new sources out of the shadows who will present to us the unbiased truth - even when it’s not politically correct.

FAMILY

Oh Lord! Resurrect in us an unparalleled love for for the unborn, and for the sanctity of life. In or marriages, put to death our stubborn pride and resurrect in us mutual love, respect and honor for one another.

REVIVAL
