"Are You A Beacon?"

One night last week, my dog and I went out for her "last call" as dusk approached. It's like a dark cloud moves in and brings with it doom and gloom - some of my in-laws (sorry Vicki) were like that - whenever we visited them it was like walking into an atmosphere where the barometric pressure had dropped considerably!
